The Center for Global Asia at NYU Shanghai serves as the hub within the NYU Global Network University system to promote the study of Asian interactions and comparisons, both historical and contemporary. The overall objective of the Center is to provide global societies with information on the contexts for the reemerging connections between the various parts of Asia through research and teaching. This includes exploring how the politics and societies of Asia have interacted over time and are now beginning to interact again on broad fronts. The Center also encourages the examination of Asia's connections with the wider world, focusing specifically on how these connections have in the past and at present impact Asian societies.

Collaborating not only with the various NYU campuses and portal sites, but also with other institutions across the world, the Center seeks to play a bridging role between existing Asian studies knowledge silos. It will take the lead in drawing connections and comparisons between the existing fields of Asian studies, and stimulating new ways of understanding Asia in a globalized world.

中心简介

作为纽约大学全球教育体系内的一个重要科研教学基地，上海纽约大学环球亚洲研究中心以推动古今亚洲内各地区之间的交往和比较研究为其核心使命。中心力求通过科研以及教学活动，为国际社会揭示并厘清亚洲各国家及地区间近年来逐渐恢复密切交往的历史背景及现实意义。这些研究除了着重关注亚洲的各个政体与社会在历史上曾经如何互联、互通、互动，以及近些年这些联系在更广阔的领域内的延续，本中心还将大力支持对于亚洲与世界其他地区之间的联系进行研究，尤其将关注这些联系对亚洲社会的过去及现在的影响。

通过与纽约大学的各门户校园、海外学习中心，以及全世界许多其它研究组织的合作，中心旨在为长期以来处于相互分离与隔绝状态的不同亚洲研究知识体系间架设纽带与桥梁。上海纽约大学环球亚洲研究中心必将在推动既有的亚洲研究领域之间的联系和比较研究方面发挥带头作用，并将激发在全球化背景下更好理解亚洲的新视角、新思路。

中心研究与活动

本中心的科研与教学活动将围绕亚洲各国家与地区间的相互交流, 以及全球化视野下的亚洲等相关课题展开。除上海纽约大学已有的研究团队外, 中心还为有志于推动亚洲各地间的互动与交流, 亚洲与世界其它地区的沟通与联系, 以及亚洲社会的比较研究的学者提供博士后岗位。

上海纽约大学作为纽约大学全球教育系统的三个最重要的分校之一, 与纽约大学本部和阿布扎比分校的密切合作是本中心研究议程的一个重要部分。由亨利·卢斯基金会资助的“全球亚洲的印度洋环境”项目(2018–2021年)促进了三个校区间合作研究的开展。本中心也是麦吉尔大学印度洋世界中心及其跨学科研究项目“评估今昔风险: 审视历史数据, 加深对印度洋地区环境危机的理解”的伙伴机构。此外, 本中心曾与德国哈勒–维腾贝格大学跨学科区域研究中心合作, 开设以“环印度洋及欧亚大陆间联系”为主题的暑期课程, 该项目为期3年(2016–2018年), 由大众汽车基金会提供资助。中心还与复旦大学亚洲研究中心共同举办年会, 编写学术期刊及通讯, 并设立联合博士后项目。

Activities and Collaborations

The Center promotes research and teaching of courses related to Asian interactions and global Asia by NYU Shanghai faculty. It also offers post-doctoral fellowships to scholars interested in advancing research and teaching of intra-Asian interactions and Asia’s connections to other parts of the world, as well as comparative study of Asian societies.

Collaborative work between the three global campuses of NYU -- New York, Abu Dhabi and Shanghai -- is an integral part of the Center’s research agenda. The Henry Luce Foundation grant for a collaborative project (2018-2021) on “Indian Ocean Environments in Global Asia” has facilitated joint research among the three campuses. The Center is also a partner institution of McGill University’s Indian Ocean World Center and its multidisciplinary research project entitled “Appraising Risk, Past and Present: Interrogating Historical Data to Enhance Understanding of Environmental Crises in the Indian Ocean World”. Additionally, the Center and the Center for Interdisciplinary Area Studies (ZIRS) at the Martin Luther University Halle-Wittenberg, Germany, completed a three-year summer school program (2016-2018) on “The Indian Ocean World and Eurasian Connections” supported by a grant from the Volkswagen Foundation. The Center also collaborates with the Asia Research Center, Fudan University, to co-host annual conferences, jointly edit academic journals and newsletter, and offers a joint postdoctoral fellowship.
